



Kensington Pond Footbridge in Centennial Park – November 2020 Update

In planning for Tomorrow's Sydney, we are building a new pedestrian footbridge over Kensington Pond to connect the light rail along Alison Rd to Centennial Park

What we're doing in November within Centennial Park

Construction work is now well underway on the Kensington Ponds pedestrian bridge which will connect Centennial Park with the Royal Randwick Light Rail stop. This month our works involve the following:

- Onsite connection of bridge balustrade.
- Concreting of reinforced beams.
- Installation of remaining joists along the concrete beams.
- Partially removing the crane platform.

This work will require the use of a 5t excavator and a tipper truck.

Location of the works

This stage of construction will take place in Centennial Park along the western bank of Kensington Ponds. We will also be working on the Sydney light rail boardwalk where the bridge is to tie in.

How will these works affect you?

Some of this work will be noisy. All work is to be held during standard hours and vehicles will be switched off when not in use. Any dust generating activities will be watered down.

Traffic Impacts

You may experience some disruption in Centennial Park, however impacts will be minimised wherever possible. Traffic Control will be in place at our truck holding bay on Grand Drive during operating hours. No vehicular detours will be made during this month.

There is no pedestrian access to the western bank of Kensington Pond. Signage has been placed around the compound to assist pedestrians.

Pedestrian and cycle traffic will be temporarily altered on the Sydney Light Rail Board Walk to accommodate for the work involved in the bridge tie-in. Pedestrians will be directed down the adjacent ramps and around the work area. Please refer to the attached mud map for more information.
